Preface

In 2019, the State Archives was once again fully committed to carrying out its core missions, namely acquiring, preserving and making archives accessible (collection management), supervising and assisting public authorities in carrying out sound archive management (archives supervision & advice), digitising records and making them available online (digitisation) and service to the public in our reading rooms and at our numerous events (service to the public).

The present publication provides an overview of key figures that reflect the work carried out in the State Archives repositories across Belgium.

On March 1st, the State Archives in Saint-Hubert has closed its doors for good; the State Archives now counts 19 repositories, each one equipped with a reading room. The archive holdings, collections and competences of the State Archives in Saint-Hubert were transferred to the State Archives in Arlon. The figures derived from the activities of the State Archives in Saint-Hubert in January and February 2019 were added to the figures of the State Archives in Arlon.

The figures contained in the tables first and foremost reflect the key duties carried out by our collaborators in Brussels, Wallonia, Flanders and in some Central Services. A lot of the work carried out on site or online is not reflected in these figures however, for instance with regard to communication, digital archiving, international relations or (scientific) activities developed within our directorates or by our data protection officer, who was appointed in 2019. In 2020, our data collection policy will be revised.

The descriptions of our numerous activities are rather generic and cover a whole range of various products and services. For instance, the heading "Articles/publications" encompasses both short articles for the general public and exhaustive scientific studies.

We invite interested readers to visit the website of the State Archives at www.arch.be and discover the multitude and variety of activities we carry out and the range of services and publications on offer. We hope that the "Facts & Figures 2019" inspire you to have a closer look.




